Seems that these updates are coming daily – but I need to keep you posted on how everything is going at the Capital – **Because we need your help.**

Our lobbyist Skin Edge advised today that Speaker of the House David Ralston requested that HB 1048 be returned to the House Agriculture and Consumer Affairs committee – before being discussed in the House Rules Committee.

The purpose of this U-turn is to clean up some language in HB 1048 that is problematic. Three items have been questioned:

- Do I need a WDO inspection when I inherit property?
- Do I need a WDO inspection if I am given property?
- Specify that the WDO inspection is not part of the deed.

So, today HB 1048 left Rules and returned to House Ag & Consumer Affairs.

Stop calling Rules members

Start calling House Ag again. (List attached)

We understand that the Realtors and others opposed to the legislation are burning up the phone and emails lines. So don't be shy. This is important.

We expect House Ag to hold another hearing, likely next week, and we have every expectation of the Bill again passing through their committee – **especially if you call.**
