The Bob Russell Entomology Scholarship was established in 2005 to honor long-time member and dedicated leader Robert M. Russell. It was Mr. Russell's vision in the 1980's to seek an Urban Entomology Program at the University of Georgia. This scholarship honors his memory and will serve to encourage those students who seek to pursue Entomology as a course of study.

The program is funded by the interest earned from a trust fund established by the Russell family and Bob's friends who have contributed memorial gifts to honor him.
