

Glenn Burnett Scholarship

The Glenn Burnett Scholarship was established in the early 80's. Since 1986 over \$112,000 has been awarded to GPCA member's children to support their attendance at a Georgia College or University.

Named after Glenn Burnett who dedicated more than 20 years of service to the association, the scholarship program has continued to grow in participation and funding through the years. Funded by the GPCA Charity Golf Tournament, the program is well established and an integral part of GPCA

Each year the Georgia Pest Control Association awards one or more scholarships to students whose parent or guardian is actively engaged in the pest control industry. These funds can be used to further the recipients' education at the Georgia college or university of choice. PROCEDURE

1. The Scholarship fund is administered by a committee of four (4) from the Georgia Pest Control Association: immediate past president, the secretary, one member at large, appointed by the president and the executive director.
2. The scholarship is funded from the interest received from Georgia Pest Control Association invested reserve funds and a portion of conference registration from the winter conference.
3. Amount of scholarship to be determined by the funds available and the scholarship committee. As example, the quality of applicants and the amount of funds may warrant the awarding of more than one (1) scholarship in a given year.
4. All funds are paid to the scholarship recipient and their parents in August.
5. All applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

1300 SAT or 28 ACT Scores 3.0 Cumulative Grade Point Average

- a. Parent or legal guardian must presently be employed and have been for at least three (3) years by a licensed pest

control firm which is an active member, in good standing of the Georgia Pest Control Association and has been for more than three years.

- b. Applicant must have been accepted or be a full time (15 hours either quarter or semester) undergraduate student at a college or university within the State of Georgia which has been accredited by the Southern Association of Schools and Colleges.

- c. Have at least a 3.0 high school cumulative grade point average (equivalent to a B average) and a 1300 combined SAT or 28 ACT score.

- d. Application for Glenn H. Burnett Scholarship must be completed along with a letter of recommendation from the licensed PCO of the GPCA member firm and received by the Executive Director of the Georgia Pest Control Association on or before April 15 of the year in which the scholarship is awarded.

6. The scholarship shall be awarded in the following order of requirements:

- a. All eligibility requirements are met.

- b. Applicants who are entering freshmen.

- c. Applicants whose parents or legal guardian are full time service technicians. (Where the parent or legal guardian holds a position that combines any two (2) or more positions, then the first position listed will be the one considered.)

- d. Applicants whose parents or legal guardian are full time sales, office staff or in supervisory position.

- e. Applicants whose parents or legal guardians are managers or owners.

- f. Applicants with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 from high school, or if currently enrolled in a College or University, a 3.0 from that school, and meets all the eligibility requirements.

- g. The highest combined score on SAT or ACT.

- h. The applicant whose sponsoring company has the longest active membership in the Georgia Pest Control Association.

- i. The applicant whose parents or legal guardian has the longest continual employment by the Georgia Pest Control Association or firm.
